



## Header Sun Cap Plus Installation Instructions

**For: Wrangler 1997 - 2002**

**Part Number: 41530**

To be used with or without Soundbar  
To be used with or without Door Surround Side Rails

**Important Note: Must be used with a TJ Header Windshield Channel Kit, Part Number 51238-01.**



### WARNING

This product is designed to enhance the appearance of the vehicle and to shield the occupants from ordinary weather conditions. **WEAR SEAT BELTS AT ALL TIMES**

Read and follow, precisely, all installation instructions provided when installing top. Failure to do so may result in a poor fitting top and could place occupants of the vehicle in a potentially dangerous situation. After installing or reinstalling the top, check to make sure it has been properly installed.

### Installation Tips

*After completing the installation, keep these instructions for future reference. Before you begin installing this product, read all instructions thoroughly. Below are a few tips to make this installation easier.*

#### **For a smooth fit:**

For ease in installation, this product should be installed at temperatures above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit to the vehicle.

It is normal for the fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after the installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.


## Parts List

Sun Cap Plus

Qty - 1

### Step One


Orient the Sun Cap Plus on the vehicle and drape it over the bows. Insert the plastic strip sewn along the front of the Sun Cap Plus into the windshield channel. Do not catch the fabric in the channel. Center the Sun Cap Plus on the vehicle so that it is an equal distance from the top of the windshield flange on both sides.



### Step Two - Without Soundbar

Drape the fabric over the sport bar. Make sure that the center strap is behind the center sport bar, and that the side straps and buckles hang off the side.


Wrap the long center strap, inside the Sun Cap Plus around the sport bar, pull the strap forward to the windshield. Then pull the end of the strap back and thread it through the buckle. Tighten it securely.



## Step Two - With Soundbar


Drape the fabric over the sport bar. Make sure that the web strap and buckle on the sides of the Sun Cap Plus are on the outside, and that the long center strap is resting on top of the soundbar.

Push the end of the center strap between the sport bar and the soundbar. Push the end of the strap through until you can get a hold of the strap to pull the buckle through. Wrap the center strap inside the Sun Cap Plus around the sport bar, pull the strap forward to the windshield. Thread the strap through the footman loop on the windshield frame. Then pull the end of the strap back and thread it through the buckle. Tighten it securely.




**Note:** Some soundbars fit extremely tight against the sport bar preventing the buckles easy access to the straps. If this is the case, the soundbar must be moved slightly rearward. The distance will vary on each vehicle.

**Remove the four bolts securing the soundbar in place. Reposition the soundbar rearward (check the clearance for buckle accessibility), notch out the soundbar attachment brackets accordingly - in most cases it will be less than 1/4". Reinstall the four bolts.**







## Step Three

Locate the hook and loop strips sewn to each side of the Sun Cap Plus. Fasten the strips to each other as you wrap them around the front sport bars.



## Step Four

Wrap the strap sewn to the side of the Sun Cap Plus around the sport bar and thread it through the buckle on the other side of the bar.



## Step Five

Locate the Buckles and straps sewn to the rear corners of the sun Cap Plus. Wrap the straps around the sport bars and under the seat belt mounts. Thread the ends of the straps through the buckles and pull them tight.
